MATERIAL for Life Groups and for Discipleship Triplets

15th Meeting **THEME: The things that make for peace**

Prepare yourself, pray for your meeting. Read Luke 19. Observe the difference between how the chief tax collector received Jesus and how the chief priests at Jerusalem would begin to receive him.

20.00 – 20.05 Icebreaker to begin with: We all love to have a feeling of peace. Which things disturbed that feeling and how did you deal with that?

20.05 – 20.10 Pray Ask God for His Holy Spirit to speak to you through His Word today.

20.10 – 20.40 Bible passage **Read: Luke 19:28-48 (we'll focus on vs. 37-44)**

Look again at verses 37 - 38 **Why the disciples rejoiced**

- What, according to Luke, was the main reason for the joyful singing of the disciples?
- What should we do practically with these two verses?

Look again at verses 39 - 40 **What some Pharisees requested for**

- Why do you think did the Pharisees ask Jesus to rebuke his disciples?
- How must we understand Jesus' answer?
- What can we learn from these verses?

Look again at verses 41 – 44 **Why Jesus cried**

- Can you explain in your own words why Jesus cried when he saw Jerusalem?
- What may have been the aim that we should come to know about these tears?

20.40 – 20.50 Digging deeper: The things that make for peace

We all need the peace with God through faith in Jesus Christ. To receive this peace. And to keep standing in it. We shouldn't approach our peace with the things that disturb us. We should approach the things that disturb us from the peace that we have received. Read Romans 5:1-2 and Philippians 4:4-7. Take some minutes of silence. Is there something you want to keep in mind the upcoming week or time?
